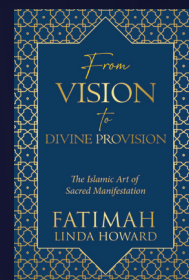

Fatimah Linda Howard

Fatimah Linda Howard is the author of two books at the intersection of faith, identity, and the inner life. A graduate of the University of Pennsylvania Carey Law School, she has spent more than three decades in leadership across law, corporate, and DEI — work she still carries through her consultancies With-LindaHoward and Alturnative. Alongside that career she has carried a lifelong contemplative practice in du'a, dhikr, and study of Qur'an and Sunnah.



Her debut, *Crescent Over Crossroads: An African American Muslim Professional Woman's Quest for Identity* (Alturnative, 2024), is a memoir of race, religion, and gender — the story of carrying an Islamic identity through Corporate America and the legal field, with spiritual journeys across America, Morocco, Mecca, and Jordan. Her second book, *From Vision to Divine Provision: The Islamic Art of Sacred Manifestation* (Alturnative, 2025), is the synthesis of her three decades of practice — a seven-step Islamic framework for sacred manifestation that rose to Amazon #1 in three Islamic categories on launch. Both books are part of the Path of Divine Alignment Series.

Fatimah is the founder of Sabil Experiences, a premium retreat brand for Muslim travelers. Her inaugural cohort — nine days, four cities, eight women — debuts in Morocco in September 2026 and walks *From Vision to Divine Provision* in real time, in the cities where it was written. She leads Sisters' Steadfast Saturdays, a monthly gathering for Muslim women, and speaks regularly to professional, faith, and wellness audiences. Her work is for the Muslim woman who has quietly asked, 'is there a version of this for us?' — and is ready for the answer she has been carrying all along.

Fatimah Linda Howard is the Amazon #1 bestselling author of *From Vision to Divine Provision: The Islamic Art of Sacred Manifestation* and the memoir *Crescent Over Crossroads*. A graduate of the University of Pennsylvania Carey Law School with over three decades of leadership across law, corporate, and DEI, she writes and teaches at the intersection of Islamic practice and the inner life — what she calls sacred manifestation. Her work offers Muslim women a framework rooted entirely in Qur'an and Sunnah, in language that meets them where they actually live.

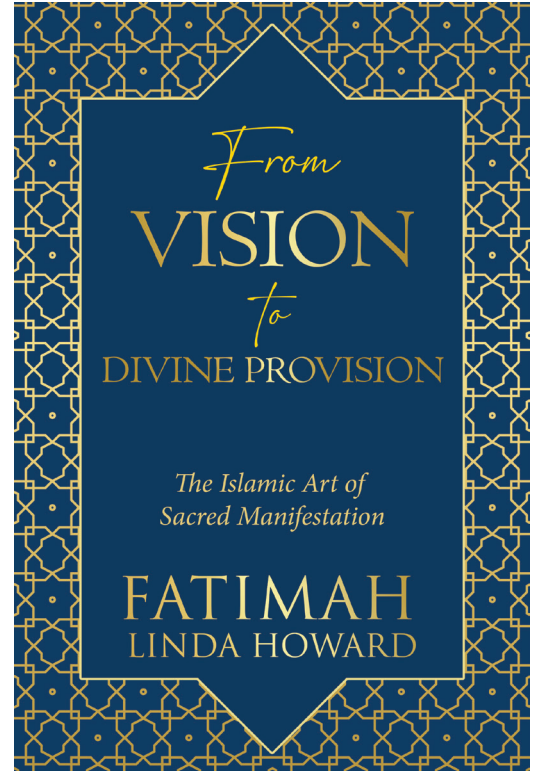
